



Aware of the urgent and continuing need to come together in the **French-speaking world** to :

- confront the challenges posed by social inequalities and their impact on health,
- adopt a global vision of health in an international context,
- learn from the lessons of the COVID-19 pandemic and the deleterious consequences of climate change,

We, as contributors to a synergy to combat desertification in healthcare, and sharing a set of common values that guide our action, commit to a healthcare partnership adapted to the territories and cooperation of French-speaking and international organizations.

We are pursuing five strategic orientations to support equitable access to healthcare in the French-speaking world:

- reaffirm the strategic ambition of the French-speaking world for health, in the face of the fracturing of the global health order, highlighted by the Covid-19 pandemic;
- to make healthcare accessible in all countries of the French-speaking world, through humanism and solidarity, the foundation for the defense of people's interests;
- design a model for access to healthcare based on a partnership approach to provide the capacity to meet healthcare needs in all regions;
- to ensure that healthcare training protects the vital interests of the population, and that academic skills are adapted to the distribution needs of professionals;
- support civil society in its efforts to improve health education and get involved in health democracy.

We have identified five executive plans implemented through joint actions for health promotion in all territories:

- promote **social responsibility in health care** in health care and training institutions, and encourage scientific research through an interventional approach to population health;
- implement **an exchange and observation platform** for healthcare partnership experiments in the territories, to mobilize expertise, skills and experiential knowledge and improve access to healthcare resources;
- promote **the use of digital technology** to facilitate openness to interprofessional collaboration, new skills and co-learning, and remote health services;
- provide **students and young citizens** with the skills they need to meet healthcare challenges, and foster a spirit of commitment;
- develop a **policy of scientific influence** with decision-makers to encourage, support and perpetuate territorial partnerships in the service of the health of underserved populations.

With this declaration, We, the partners of the Initiative:

- affirm our willingness to contribute to this dynamic, and invite other French-speaking partners with expertise in the field to join us,
- and we hope that this cooperation between all players will make the French-speaking world a global benchmark for efficient, equitable and supportive public health policies.
